WHAT ARE THE RECOMMENDED EXAMS ?

Clinical Breast Exam

A healthcare provider examines your breast with the professional care you deserve.

Mammogram

An X-ray picture of your breast that can show even the smallest changes that might need attention.

Pelvic Exam

A healthcare provider checks your cervix, ovaries, and pelvic area for masses, growths, or other issues. A Pap smear may be performed during a pelvic exam.

Pap Smear

A procedure that involves a healthcare provider using a swab to collect cells from your cervix to test for cervical cancer.
