- Mammograms can find breast cancers before they can be detected by breast exams.
- Many women do not have symptoms at the time breast cancer is detected.
- The chance of survival increases if cancer is found early.
- Detecting cervical cancer before it spreads is very easy with regular Pap tests.

## WHAT ARE THE RECOMMENDED EXAMS ?

### Clinical Breast Exam

A doctor or nurse examines your breast with the professional care you deserve.

### X-Ray

An X-Ray picture of your breast that can show even the smallest changes that might need attention.

### Pelvic Exam

A short procedure that checks the cervix (the opening of the womb), ovaries and uterus for masses, growths or other issues. A Pap test may be performed during a pelvic exam.

### Pap Test

A procedure that involves collecting cells from the cervix to test for cervical cancer. It is also known as a Pap Smear.
