HEALTH SERVICES

Family planning services are available during and after clinic hours to current DOH-Duval clinic patients and walk-in clients (during afternoon classes).

Services include:

- Reproductive health education
- Pregnancy testing and counseling
- STD prevention education, counseling, testing, and treatment
- Preconception health education
- Birth control counseling
- Individual and group health education

ABSTINENCE EDUCATION

Interactive, skills-based sessions for youth groups ages 11-19 include the following topics:

- Dream and goal setting
- Puberty
- STD/HIV/AIDS prevention
- Negotiation practice

Sessions are also available for adults on "Talking with Teens about Sex".

The Family Planning Team can offer sessions in a variety of settings such as faith-based organizations, afterschool programs, community centers, and youth camps.

Services are available in Duval, Clay, St. Johns, and Nassau counties.

PEER HEALTH ADVOCACY PROGRAM

Peer Health Advocates are professionally trained teens and young adults that help their friends, classmates, and peers learn skills to reduce their risk for unintended pregnancy, STDs, and HIV.
