On **December 1st**, we recognize the global impact of the HIV epidemic through **World AIDS Day**. There are approximately **35 million people worldwide living with HIV**, more than 1.2 million of whom are in the United States. While we have made strides in the fight against HIV, we must sustain these efforts and do more to reach the goal of an AIDS-free generation.

In Area 4 (Baker, Clay, Duval, Nassau, and St. Johns Counties) 332 people were newly diagnosed with HIV in 2022. Duval County accounts for 88.5% of those newly diagnosed.

*Viral suppression and undetectable viral load mean to have less than 200 copies of HIV per milliliter of blood if you are virally suppressed it prevents transmission.
